### Compromising Sentences

If you are having trouble coming up with possible compromises, try finishing the following sentences:

I could see coming forward/give in this way \_\_\_\_\_

I would be able to come forward/give this amount \_\_\_\_\_.

I would be able to come forward/give about this part \_\_\_\_\_

I would be able to give on \_\_\_\_\_ if \_\_\_\_\_  
(my spouse gives in on this part of the issue).

I would be able to give on \_\_\_\_\_ this time, if next time my spouse would be ok with \_\_\_\_\_, or if my spouse gave on \_\_\_\_\_ (some other issue, maybe).

I could be ok with only doing or not doing \_\_\_\_\_ now, and then at a later time doing \_\_\_\_\_.

Share with each other where and under what circumstances you could change your request.

After looking at it this way, is there a compromise that would bring this to resolution?

Try out different possibilities and combinations. You might need to go back and forth to get to compromise.

Resolution: Resolution is achieved when one of you suggests a compromise that the other says they can agree to.
